Whereas, D.C. Official Code Section 38-2652 (a)(3) requires the State Board of Education to approve certain standards including high school graduation requirements;

Whereas, the State Board of Education recognizes that the emergency proposed rules address technical clarifications with regard to graduation requirements;

Whereas, the Office of the State Superintendent of Education has discussed this proposal with representatives from the District of Columbia public schools, and the Public Charter School Board;


Whereas, the emergency rule shall go into effect for a maximum of 120 days, during which time the public will have an opportunity to comment on the proposed rule before it becomes final;

Whereas, the State Board of Education has held a public forum this evening to discuss the proposed revisions;

Whereas, the State Board of Education has considered all comments and presentations received;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Board of Education approves the emergency and proposed rulemaking and requests public comment on the proposed revisions to Title 5, subtitle E, chapter 22 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations;
