PARCC Technology Updates

While DC will **NOT** be participating in PARCC fall block testing, the [PARCC 2016 Fall Block Technology Crosswalk](#) has valuable technology update information. Highlights include:

- Student enrollment limited to one organization at a time
- Preparing test sessions prior to unlocking test sessions
- Default file extension to “CSV” for file import/export
- Coming soon: blacklist applications
- TI graphing calculator and drawing tool updates
- Touchscreen function in TestNav
- New version of ProctorCache required for 2016-17 administration

PARCC Technology Updates

- Student enrollment limited to one organization at a time
 - Students who transfer between LEAs can have their PARCC accounts transferred in PANext through something called a “Work Request” initiated by an LEA.
 - Details on this process will be available in September.
- **Preparing** test sessions prior to starting test sessions
 - **Preparing** test sessions assigns TestNav login credentials and forms to each student in the test session.
 - This will expedite the process of starting a large number of tests at the same time, as forms will already be assigned.
 - This task is completed by the School Test Coordinator role.
 - It is imperative that student ***accommodations are updated*** in the test registration before **Preparing** the test session.

PARCC Technology Updates

- Default file extension to “CSV” for file import/export
- Coming soon: blacklist applications
 - The new blacklist feature will prevent TestNav from launching the test if certain applications are still active during the sign in process.
 - An error message will warn Test Administrators if this occurs.
- TI graphing calculator and drawing tool updates
 - TI graphing calculator can now move in any direction (not just sideways).
 - Drawing tool (3rd grade math only) includes updated icons and can now draw dots with one click/touch.

PARCC Technology Updates

- Touchscreen function in TestNav
 - Touchscreen Chromebooks and Windows touchscreen devices are supported on the TestNav Desktop App and can utilize the touch functionality to navigate and respond in TestNav
- New version of ProctorCache required for 2016-17 administration
 - New Fall 2016 software listings are available in the [PARCC 2016 Fall Blook Technology Crosswalk](#). Previous versions of ProctorCache cannot be used to download and deliver test content.

Health and Physical Education Assessment

- The District of Columbia's *Healthy Schools Act of 2010* requires the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) to report on student achievement with respect to health and physical education standards
- District students are tested annually in fifth grade, eighth grade, and high school (during the year in which health class is provided) on their health and physical education knowledge



2016 Health and Physical Education Assessment

- Field test the option of LEAs administering their own data collection
- For those LEAs opting into the OSSE-created assessment, field test the proposed health standards to be implemented in the 2016-17 school year

Post assessment surveys were conducted for
both assessments



2016 OSSE Health Assessment Survey Results

Respondents

- Total respondents: 59*
 - Health Assessment Coordinators: 45 (76.3%)
 - Health Assessment Proctors: 13 (22%)
 - Other: 4 (6.8%)
 - PARCC Administrator
 - Curriculum Coordinator-Health Assessment Support
 - Testing Chair
 - Test Coordinator

*Some respondents identified themselves as both the Health Assessment Coordinator and Proctor

Positive feedback

- The assessment was simple to administer
- The platform was easy to use, required minimal network preparation, and was easily used by the students
- The administration window was appropriate
- The guidance documents and/or assistance tools provided for the assessment were useful

Areas of improvement

- Greater alignment to other District-wide assessments
- Provide LEAs with the capability to monitor student completion rates
- Ability to view a student's name on the testing screen after they have entered their testing ID
- Offer a longer, more thorough assessment
- Create actual student tickets vs. providing an Excel file
- Deliver earlier communications around assessment
- Simpler student IDs*
- Include accommodations in the testing platform*

*Cannot be changed for the 2017 administration



2017 Health and Physical Education Assessment

2017 Health and Physical Education Assessment

- Online only
 - Same platform
- No hardship waivers
- Large print paper version will be available for students that require such accommodation

General improvements

- Using OSSE Support Tool instead of the Secure File Transfer Protocol
- Communications will be included in the NGA Bulletin
- Provide communications earlier in the school year
- Offer training for the Health Assessment Coordinator
- Additional guidance on creating curricula that increases student knowledge of the health and physical education standards
- Assessment will be longer and more comprehensive

 - Fulfill due dates related to the assessment
 - Access the OSSE Support Tool on behalf of the LEA
 - Distribute materials to schools
