# **TEST INTEGRITY: CAVEON DATA FORENSICS METHODOLOGY**

# 2014-15 and 2015-16 TI Timeline

September-October 2016	<p><b>2016 School Identification and Investigations and Follow Up to 2015 Investigations</b></p> <p>Caveon will be analyzing 2016 PARCC results in August and September. In September and October, OSSE will notify LEAs and Caveon will conduct additional investigations in schools identified for investigation based on 2016 assessments, as well as follow up investigations at some of the 2015 schools if warranted based upon the 2016 data or other evidence obtained by investigators.</p>
December 2016-January 2017	<p><b>Reports and Appeals</b></p> <p>LEAs receive full test integrity investigation reports from OSSE for all 2015 and 2016 investigations, including any findings, and have the opportunity to review and appeal those results. There will be two levels of appeal: the first level with OSSE, and the second level with the Deputy Mayor for Education's office.</p>
January 2017	<p><b>Public Release</b></p> <p>LEAs will receive final determinations from appeals. OSSE will publicly release redacted copies of investigation reports and final findings.</p>

# 2015-16 PARCC Reporting Timeline

## Complete:

**May 16-June 15:** LEA Student Demographic and Enrollment Verification

**July 14:** OSSE delivers preliminary PARCC score and participation data to LEAs

**July 14-25:** LEA PARCC participation verification window

**July 17:** OSSE delivers preliminary MSAA score and participation data to LEAs

## In process:

**July 27-Aug 1:** LEA MSAA participation verification window

# 2015-16 PARCC Reporting Timeline

## Upcoming:

### **Late August**

- LEAs receive final data through secure upload site
- Pre-public release meeting for LEA leaders
- Public release event
- Additional communications tools released

### **Early September**

- OSSE sends schools individualized student reports (ISRs) for students they tested in spring 2016
- Schools are responsible for distributing to families

Test	Proposed Dates
WIDA ACCESS	Feb 27 – April 25
MSAA (tentative)	March 6 – May 12
PARCC Window 1	April 10 – May 26*
PARCC Window 2	April 24 – June 5
DC Science	April 24 – June 9

*\* Includes five days of school vacation for a spring break*

# Alternate Assessments

- All students in DC participate in assessments in one of three ways:
  1. The general assessment (PARCC or DC Science)
  2. The general assessment with accommodations
  3. The alternate assessments (MSAA or DC Science Alt)
- A student with a significant cognitive disability has records that indicate a disability or multiple disabilities that significantly impact intellectual functioning and adaptive behavior.


# One Percent Cap Updates

## Previous One Percent Cap under NCLB:

Only one percent of all students could take alternate assessments and be counted as proficient

## New One Percent Cap under ESSA:

Only one percent of all students can be assessed using alternate assessments in each subject (implemented 2017-18 school year)



# Alternate Assessment Eligibility

- For 2016-17 SY eligibility, it's important for LEAs to know if they currently exceed the one percent cap.
- Simplified application process for eligibility determinations, with a streamlined process for students deemed eligible in 2015-16 school year.
- 2016-17 school year eligibility determination process will include 2015-16 school year eligibility roster review and informing LEAs if they exceed the one percent cap.

# Simplified Eligibility Process 2016-17

- **Confirmed Eligible Applicants (Alt-Confirmed)**
  - ✓ Determined eligible by OSSE in prior school year
  - ✓ IEP is current in SEDS
  - ✓ Current IEP indicates “Alternate Assessment” selected by IEP team
- **New Applicants**
  - ✓ Grade 3 students
  - ✓ New to LEA
  - ✓ Traumatic brain injury
  - ✓ Misidentified and other outliers
