


OSSE's New ED Facts Data Collection Calendar and Process

EDFacts Data Elements and Data Dictionary

Data element	Data Element Definition	Accepted Values
Limited English Proficiency Status	An individual who was not born in the United States or whose native language is a language other than English and whose difficulties in speaking, reading, writing, or understanding the English language may be sufficient to deny the individual the ability to meet the State's proficient level of achievement on State assessments; the ability to successfully achieve in classrooms where the language of instruction is English; or the opportunity to participate fully in society.	LEP – Limited English proficient (LEP) Student NLEP – Non–limited English proficient (Non–LEP) Student MISSING
Mathematics Performance level	The student's performance on the Mathematics section of the DC CAS	L1 – Level 1 (lowest level - below basic) L2 – Level 2 (basic) L3 – Level 3 (proficient) L4 – Level 4 (advanced) MISSING


EDFacts Data Collection

- Four collection due dates for reporting:
 - October 10
 - December 11
 - March 1
 - July 1
- Four collections at the individual level
- Pre-populated with student rosters
- Caveat: EDFacts is our *starting* point on improving the data collection process
