Attendance at up to three additional meetings annually, when needed
Maintenance of 70 percent annual attendance rate at the Committee of Practitioners meetings
Completion of tasks as assigned by the committee
Review of provided materials ahead of meeting dates (OSSE commits to providing one-week notice for materials to be reviewed)
